- No calendar year maximum, no deductible, no claim forms, no waiting periods
- Implants and family orthodontia included
- ID cards for every member of your family

- Adult and Child Orthodontia starting at \$1,000 for full orthodontia treatment*

Diagnostic & Preventive Care	Initial and periodic oral exams, Consultations, Topical fluoride treatment, Preventive dental education and oral hygiene instruction, X-Rays, Prophylaxis (cleanings), Space maintainers, Sealants	No Charge
Restorative (fillings)	Amalgam & composite resin, Acrylic, Synthetic or plastic restorations. Replacement of a restoration, Use of pins and pin build-up in conjunction with a restoration. Sedative base and sedative fillings	No Charge
Oral Surgery	Extractions – including surgical extractions, Removal of impacted teeth, Biopsy of oral tissues, Treatment of palatal & mandibular torus, Frenectomy, Post-operative services – including exams, Suture removal and treatment of complications	A \$15 copay for removal of completely bony impacted teeth with unusual surgical complications.
Endodontics	Pulp capping and pulpotomy, Apexification, Root amputation, Root canal therapy, Retreatment of previous root canal therapy, Apicoectomy	A \$20 copay per canal for root canal therapy or retreatment of previous root canal therapy and \$50 copay per root for an apicoectomy.
Periodontics	Periodontal scaling and root planing, Subgingival curettage, Gingivectomy, Osseous surgery	A \$150 copay per quadrant for osseous surgery and \$5 copay for gingivectomy procedure involving 1-3 teeth.
Crown & Fixed Bridge	Crowns – including acrylic, acrylic with metal, porcelain, porcelain with metal, full metal, Onlay or three quarter crown, Stainless steel. Related pins and pin build-up, Replacement crowns after 3 years, Fixed bridges – including cast, porcelain baked with metal, plastic processed to gold, Recementation of crowns and bridges, Post and core – including cast retention under crowns	A \$50 copay for crowns and each unit of bridge. Additional \$75 copay applies, if porcelain, resin, or resin-based composite is used on molar crowns.
Removable Prosthetics	Complete and partial dentures, Teeth, Clasps and stress breakers, Office or laboratory relines or rebases, Denture repair, Adjustment, Tissue reconditioning, Stayplates	A \$65 copay for crowns and each unit of bridge.
Implants & Services	Surgical placement of implant body, Implant Supported Crown – including porcelain fused to metal	Copays Apply Please refer to Evidence of Coverage for specific copays and limitations.
Orthodontic Services	Adult and child standard and comprehensive orthodontic treatment, Orthodontic retention, Continuation of care for treatment in progress	\$1,000 Copay, plus additional \$250 start-up fee will apply. No cost for retention. \$25 copay will apply for each visit after 24 months.
